The new facility in Grantham will start processing product in October 2008.

All types of WEEE can be processed ranging from large domestic appliances such as Washing Machines & Dishwashers to Small Domestic Appliances including Microwaves & Toasters. Equipment with sensitive data including Computers & Servers is tracked very carefully and processed in order to ensure that all data is removed & destroyed.

Other WEEE with hazardous content that requires specialized treatment including Refrigerators, Televisions & Monitors is processed separately in plant that has been specifically designed for this equipment. Where a product has the potential for re use, it is fully tested before being placed back onto the market. All commodities such as Metals, Plastics & Glass are traded on the global materials market.

All processes operated by the Company are carefully recorded at each stage and records are provided to our customers thus ensuring complete compliance with regulatory requirements and any specific customer requests. Our new software allows for full traceability & visibility of WEEE at each stage of the process whilst our Management Systems are underpinned through accreditation to Quality & Environmental Management Standards.
